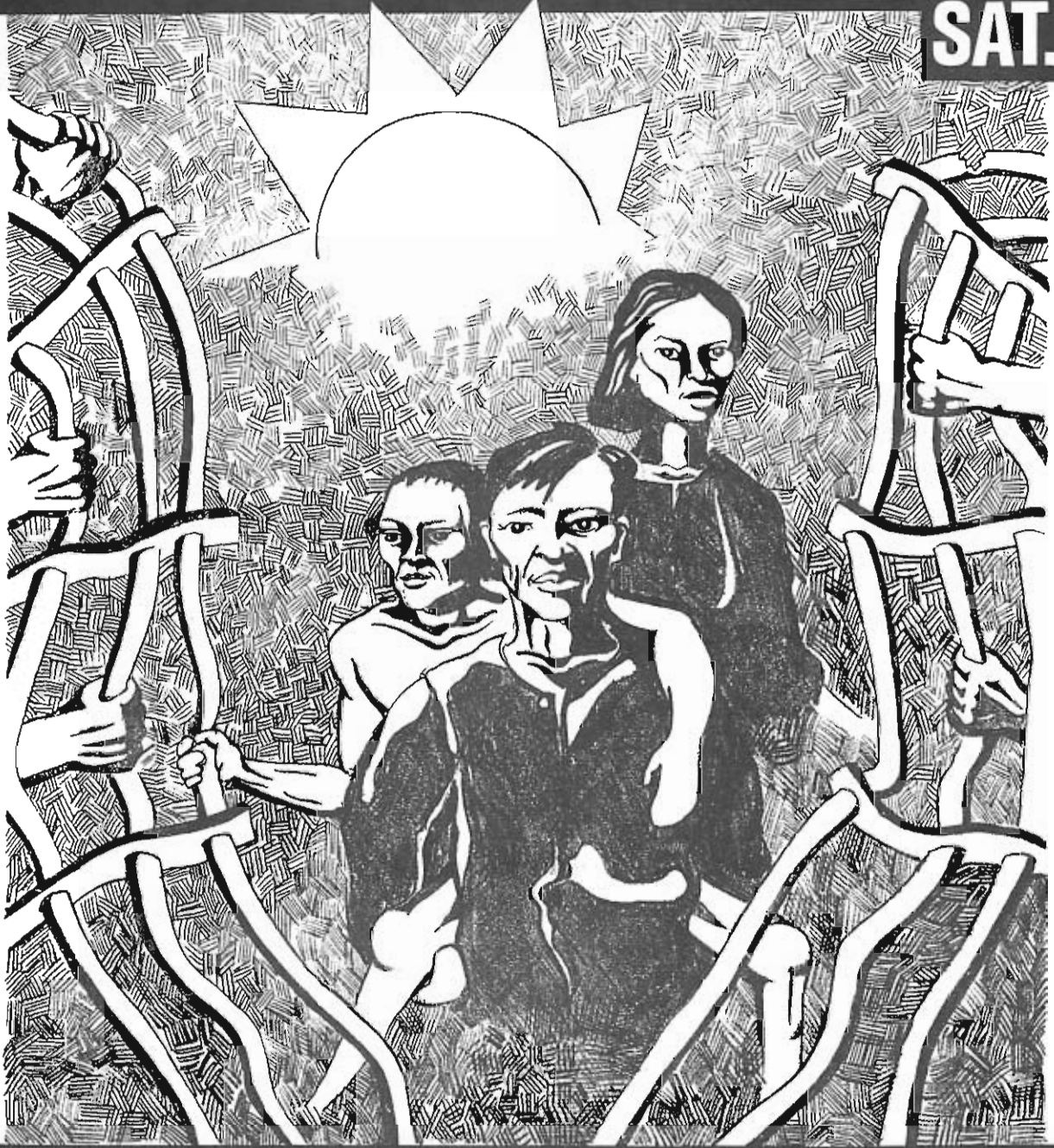

I. Release All Political Prisoners !

200,000 POLITICAL PRISONERS IN MORE THAN 1,000 PRISONS OF THE SAIGON ADMINISTRATION ARE FACING TORTURE, MUTILATION, MALTREATMENT AND LIQUIDATION.

They are common people who want PEACE, INDEPENDENCE, FREEDOM and HAPPINESS for South Viet-Nam. The Saigon administration wants to stamp out these just demands of the South Vietnamese people. South Viet-Nam has a population of 17 million. 6 million are kept in concentration camps under subhuman conditions.

"THE QUESTION OF RETURN OF VIETNAMESE CIVILIAN PERSONNEL CAPTURED AND DETAINED IN SOUTH VIET-NAM WILL BE RESOLVED BY THE SOUTH VIETNAMESE PARTIES...WITHIN NINETY DAYS AFTER THE CEASE FIRE COMES INTO EFFECT."---Paris Peace Agreement.

"...WITHIN FORTY DAYS FROM THE DATE OF SIGNATURE OF THE (JUNE 13,1973) JOINT COMMUNIQUE."---Paris Peace Agreement.

The repression of the Saigon administration upon the South Vietnamese people has not stopped even after the second deadline (August 24th). In fact, it continues on an ever widening scale.

II. Cut All U.S. Govt. Aid to Thieu !

In carrying out the above violations, the Saigon administration with it's prison system, police forces, military and paramilitary forces, is in fact being consolidated, developed, and supported by tax money of the people of the United States.

"THE UNITED STATES WILL NOT CONTINUE IT'S MILITARY INVOLVEMENT OR INTERVENE IN THE INTERNAL AFFAIRS OF SOUTH VIET-NAM".---Paris Peace Agreement.

BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS TO THE THIEU REGIME:

1. \$1.1 Billion in military aid.
2. \$200 Million in AGENCY FOR INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT projects.
3. \$8.8 Million from the DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE.
4. \$176 Million for "FOOD FOR PEACE" of which \$140 million is general military subsidy.
5. \$275 Million for COMMODITY IMPORT PROGRAM. "Saigon's use of this money has helped the police force grow almost 70% since 1968." (TIME 9/17/73)

\$4.1 BILLION IS PROJECTED FOR 1974 !!! Even now, the United States has 20,000 advisors in South Viet-Nam who are actively involved in the military and paramilitary operations for the Saigon administration

IT IS CLEAR: The PARIS PEACE AGREEMENT is a document that the U.S. government and it's Saigon administration were forced to sign in the face of mounting world public opinion, mass demonstrations and sentiment of the people of the U.S., and the undefeatable resistance of the Vietnamese people. It is consistantly being violated by both the U.S. Govt. and it's puppet Saigon administration

Lacking even the slightest support from th common people of Sout Viet-Nam, the Saigon administration has only the U.S. Govt. and open police terror to rely on. Let's make it clear that people in the U.S. see through the U.S. Govt's. lies about it's interest in "PEACE WITH HONOR". The Vietnamese think highly of the U.S. people's support for the PARIS PEACE AGREEMENT. We can show our respect for thier rights as well as indignation at our governments support for fascist Saigon administration, by joining the PICKET AND MARCH at the Saigon Consulate on NOVEMBER 17th.
